

Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine Resolution No. 730 of 4 June 2026 Kyiv

On the approval of the Procedure for the use of funds allocated in the state budget for the financing of measures relating to forestry and hunting management, and the conservation and protection of forests within the forest fund

In accordance with Part 7 of Article 20 of the Budget Code of Ukraine, the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine **resolves**:

1. To approve the attached Procedure for the use of funds allocated in the state budget for the financing of measures relating to forestry and hunting management, and the conservation and protection of forests within the forest fund.
2. To declare the resolutions of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine set out in the attached list to be repealed.
3. This resolution shall enter into force on 1 August 2026.

PROCEDURE
for the use of funds allocated in the state budget for
funding measures for the management of forestry and hunting, and the conservation
and protection of forests in the forest fund

1. This Procedure sets out the mechanism for the use of funds provided for in the state budget under the budget programme “Forest and Game Management, Conservation and Protection of Forests in the Forest Fund” for the implementation of measures relating to forest and game management, conservation and protection of forests in the forest fund (hereinafter referred to as “budget funds”).

These Regulations do not apply to budgetary institutions and institutions of the nature reserve fund that are funded under the budget programme “Forest and Game Management, Conservation and Protection of Forests in the Forest Fund”.

2. The main administrator of budget funds is the Ministry of Economy; the administrator of lower-level budget funds and the responsible executor of the budget programme is the State Forest Resources Agency.

3. The recipients of budgetary funds are business entities and their associations falling within the remit of the State Forest Resources Agency (hereinafter referred to as “recipients”).

4. Budget funds are allocated for the implementation of measures relating to forestry and hunting management, and the conservation and protection of forests within the forest fund in the following areas:

partial compensation (up to 50 per cent) of the cost of forest restoration works (purchase of planting material, establishment of forest stands and their maintenance) located in territories included in the list of territories where hostilities are (were) taking place or which are temporarily occupied by the Russian Federation, approved by Order of the Ministry of Development No. 376 of 28 February 2025
No. 376;

maintaining the state forest cadastre; conducting a
national forest inventory;

forest management (forest conservation and protection, fire protection of forests, forest regeneration) by permanent forest users engaged in the special use of forest resources, other than timber harvesting under the main use felling regime.

5. Proposals for the allocation of budget funds by area of use, as provided for in paragraph 4 of this Procedure, shall be submitted

by a commission formed by the State Forest Resources Agency, in agreement with the Ministry of Economy (hereinafter — the commission).

The regulations governing the Commission and its membership shall be approved by the State Forest Resources Agency. The Commission shall be chaired by the Head of the State Forest Resources Agency and shall comprise representatives of the State Forest Resources Agency and the Ministry of Economy.

The Commission's decision is recorded in minutes signed by all members of the Commission.

6. The amount of budgetary funds for forest management by permanent forest users engaged in the special use of forest resources, other than timber harvesting under the main use felling regime, is determined as the difference between the total standard expenditure requirement for the implementation of measures for forest and hunting management, the conservation and protection of forests within the forest fund, and the amount of own funds received by the beneficiaries from forestry activities, taking into account that funds received from the sale of timber obtained from thinning and forest regeneration felling, other forest formation and regeneration measures, other felling operations and works, related and unrelated to forestry management, are directed in full towards the management of forestry and hunting, and the conservation and protection of forests within the forest fund.

The unit cost of works related to the management of forestry and hunting, and the conservation and protection of forests within the forest fund, shall be determined by the recipient in accordance with standardised technical charts, which are calculated on the basis of standard and comprehensive production rates, time and cost norms, approved in the prescribed manner.

Partial compensation (up to 50 per cent) of the cost of forest restoration works (purchase of planting material, establishment of forest stands and their maintenance) is provided in accordance with the Rules for Forest Regeneration, approved by Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 303 of 1 March 2007 No. 303 (Official Gazette of Ukraine, 2007, No. 16, p. 589), and the Instructions on the design, technical acceptance, accounting and quality assessment of forestry objects, approved by Order of the State Committee for Forestry and Forestry Economy No. 260 of 19 August 2010.

7. The use of budget funds by their recipients is carried out in accordance with the action plan for the management of forestry and hunting, and the conservation and protection of forests in the forest fund (hereinafter — the action plan).

8. The State Forest Resources Agency draws up the action plan, which is agreed with the Ministry of Economy, and approves it.

9. To receive budgetary funds, recipients shall submit an application for the funds provided for in the state budget to finance measures for the management of forestry and hunting, and the conservation and protection of forests within the forest fund (hereinafter referred to as the 'application') between 1 and 30 January of the budget

year via the system for electronic interaction between executive authorities to the State Forest Resources Agency in the form set out in the annex.

The application shall be affixed with a qualified electronic signature or an advanced electronic signature based on the recipient's qualified electronic signature certificate.

The recipient is responsible for the accuracy of the information provided in the submitted application and the documents attached thereto, in accordance with the law.

10. The following documents shall be attached to the application:

1) for partial compensation of the cost of forest restoration works:

a report on the damage and losses caused to forestry land, linear protective plantations and hunting grounds as a result of the armed aggression of the Russian Federation, in accordance with Order No. 414 of the Ministry of Environment dated 5 October 2022 No. 414 "On the Approval of the Methodology for Determining Damage and Losses Caused to the Forest Fund as a Result of the Armed Aggression of the Russian Federation";

a forest cultivation project or a natural regeneration project, approved by the forest owner or permanent forest user (or their branch, forest district, representative office, department or other separate subdivision) in accordance with the Rules for Forest Regeneration, approved by Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of 1 March 2007 No. 303, and the Instructions on the Design, Technical Acceptance, Accounting and Quality Assessment of Forest Cultivation Sites, approved by Order of the State Committee for Forestry No. 260 of 19 August 2010;

certificate of technical acceptance of forest crops and forest plantations;

certificate of technical acceptance of natural regeneration plots and their inclusion in the total area of forest regeneration;

certificate of technical acceptance of works in the sowing sections of nurseries; field inventory card for seedlings and rooted cuttings;

field inventory card for forest crops and forest plantations of one-, two- and three-year-old age;

field certification, certification of crops, forest plantations four years old and older;

certificate of write-off of forest stands and forest plantations lost due to subjective and objective causes;

certificate of write-off of forest crops and forest plantations that have perished as a result of natural disasters;

certificate of acceptance and handover of services provided or work performed;

2) for the maintenance of the State Forest Cadastre — a production and financial plan for forestry, hunting and environmental protection;

3) for the purpose of conducting the national forest inventory — a production and financial plan for forestry, hunting and environmental protection, and an annual plan for forest inventory work;

4) for the management of forestry by permanent forest users engaged in the special use of forest resources, other than timber harvesting under the main use felling regime — a production and financial plan for forestry, hunting and environmental protection.

11. The State Forest Resources Agency shall verify applications and documents and conduct a preliminary review thereof within five working days of the date of registration of the application and documents to ensure compliance with the requirements set out in paragraphs 6, 9 and 10 of this Procedure.

Applications and documents submitted incompletely or prepared in breach of the requirements of paragraphs 6, 9 and 10 of this Procedure shall be returned to the applicants via the electronic interaction system of executive authorities, stating the reasons for the return. Recipients shall have the right to resubmit the application and revised documents in accordance with the requirements set out in paragraphs 6, 9 and 10 of this Procedure.

Where the applications and documents comply with the requirements set out in paragraphs 6, 9 and 10 of these Procedures, they shall be forwarded to the commission for the formulation of proposals regarding the allocation of budgetary funds in accordance with the draft action plan.

12. The amount of budgetary funds shall be determined within the limits of the projected revenue from rent payments for the special use of forest resources in the course of main-use felling and the balances of the special fund of the state budget as at the beginning of the year.

The allocation of budgetary funds for partial compensation of the cost of forest restoration works shall be carried out proportionally among recipients within the limits of the specified volume of budgetary funds for this area.

By 20 February of the budget year, the Commission shall draw up proposals for the allocation of budgetary funds in accordance with the draft action plan for specific areas of their use and broken down by each recipient, which shall be submitted for consideration to the Head of the State Forestry Agency.

13. The settlement of accounts payable under budgetary obligations recorded by the Treasury authorities shall be carried out in accordance with the procedure established by law.

14. The procurement of goods, works and services using budget funds is carried out in accordance with the procedure established by law.

15. The recording in primary and accounting records of information on received (created) current and non-current assets, the opening and closing of accounts, the registration and accounting of budgetary obligations with the Treasury authorities, and the conduct of operations related to the use of budgetary funds shall be carried out in accordance with the procedure established by law.

16. Recipients shall submit information on the use of budget funds to the State Forest Resources Agency on a quarterly basis by the 5th day of the following month for the purpose of monitoring the targeted use of budget funds, and the Agency shall summarise this information and submit it to the Ministry of Economy by the 10th day.

The Ministry of Economy shall submit information on the implementation of the action plan to the Ministry of Finance on a quarterly basis by the 15th day of the following month and annually by 1 February of the following year based on the results of the annual activity.

17. The preparation and submission of financial and budgetary reports on the use of budget funds, as well as the monitoring of their targeted and effective expenditure, shall be carried out in accordance with the procedure established by law.
